Woodland Crochet



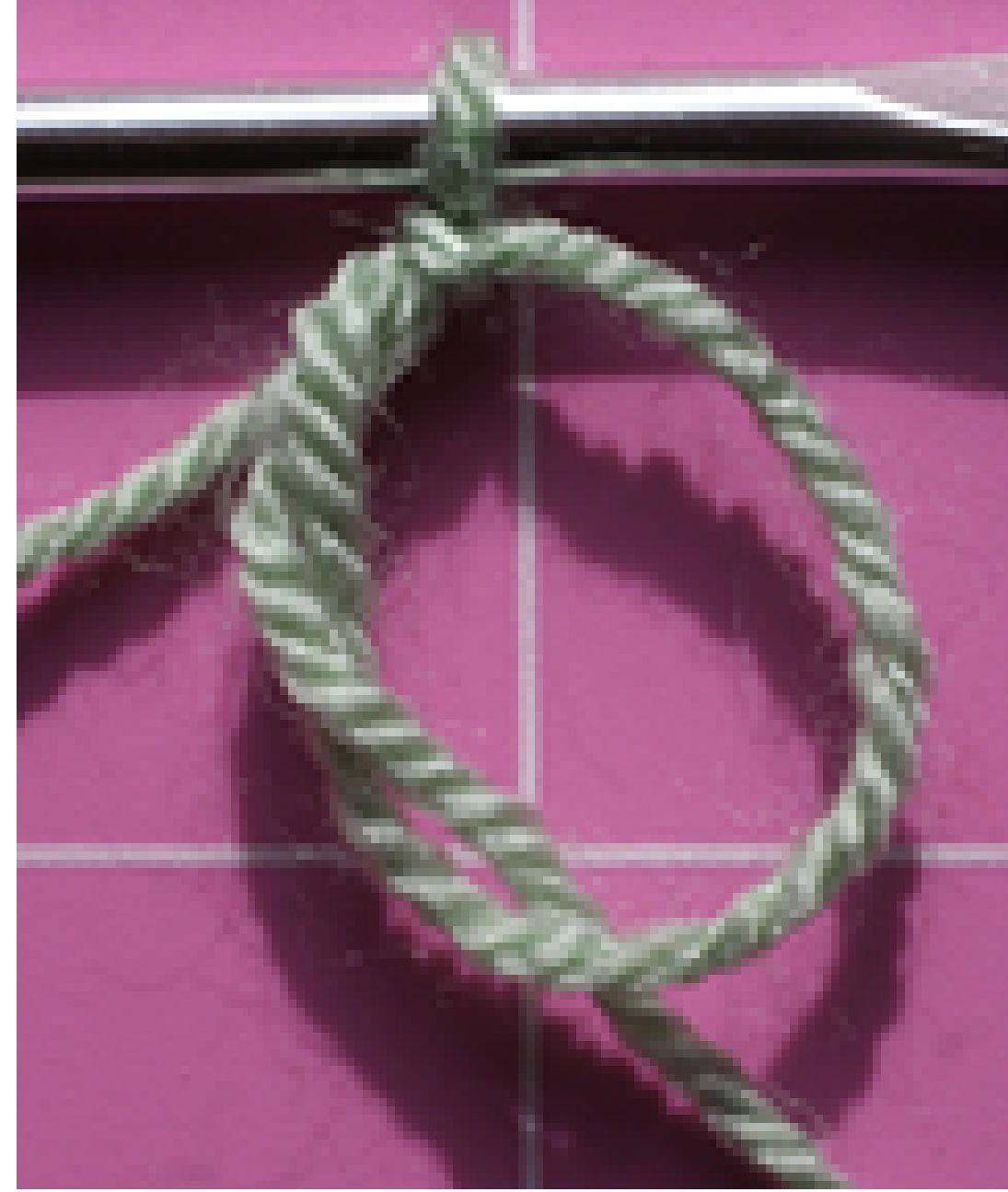
Creative activities like crochet are great mindful activities to help you focus on the present moment. Why not create your own mini crocheted tree, woodland or even forest.

Notes before starting

Each tree is started using a magic circle, and continued in US single crochet or UK double crochet stitches. A search online will show you how to do these.

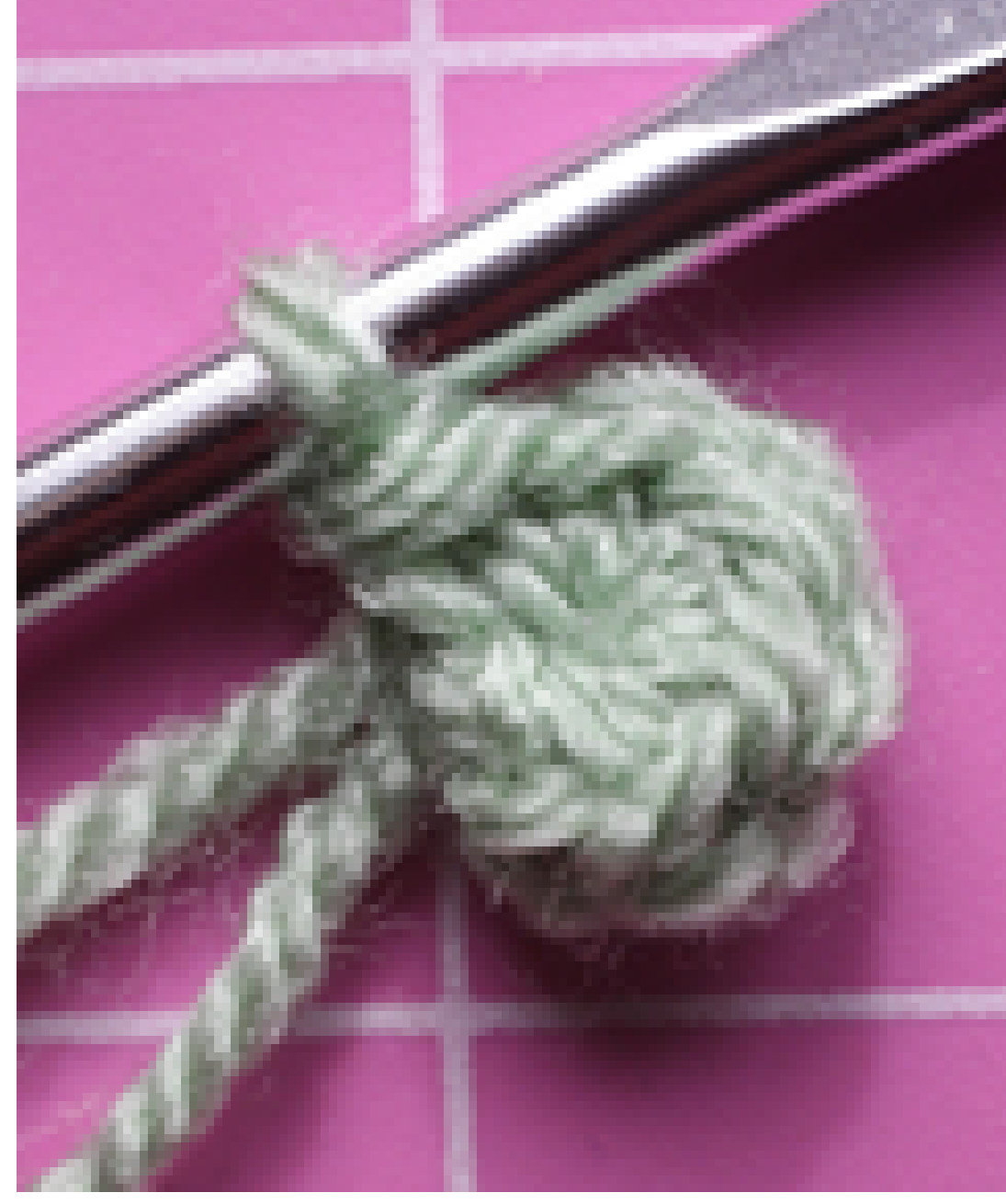
This pattern will use UK terminology —so UK double crochet stitches.

The tree is made in a continuous spiral — use a stitch marker to keep track of where each round starts/finishes.



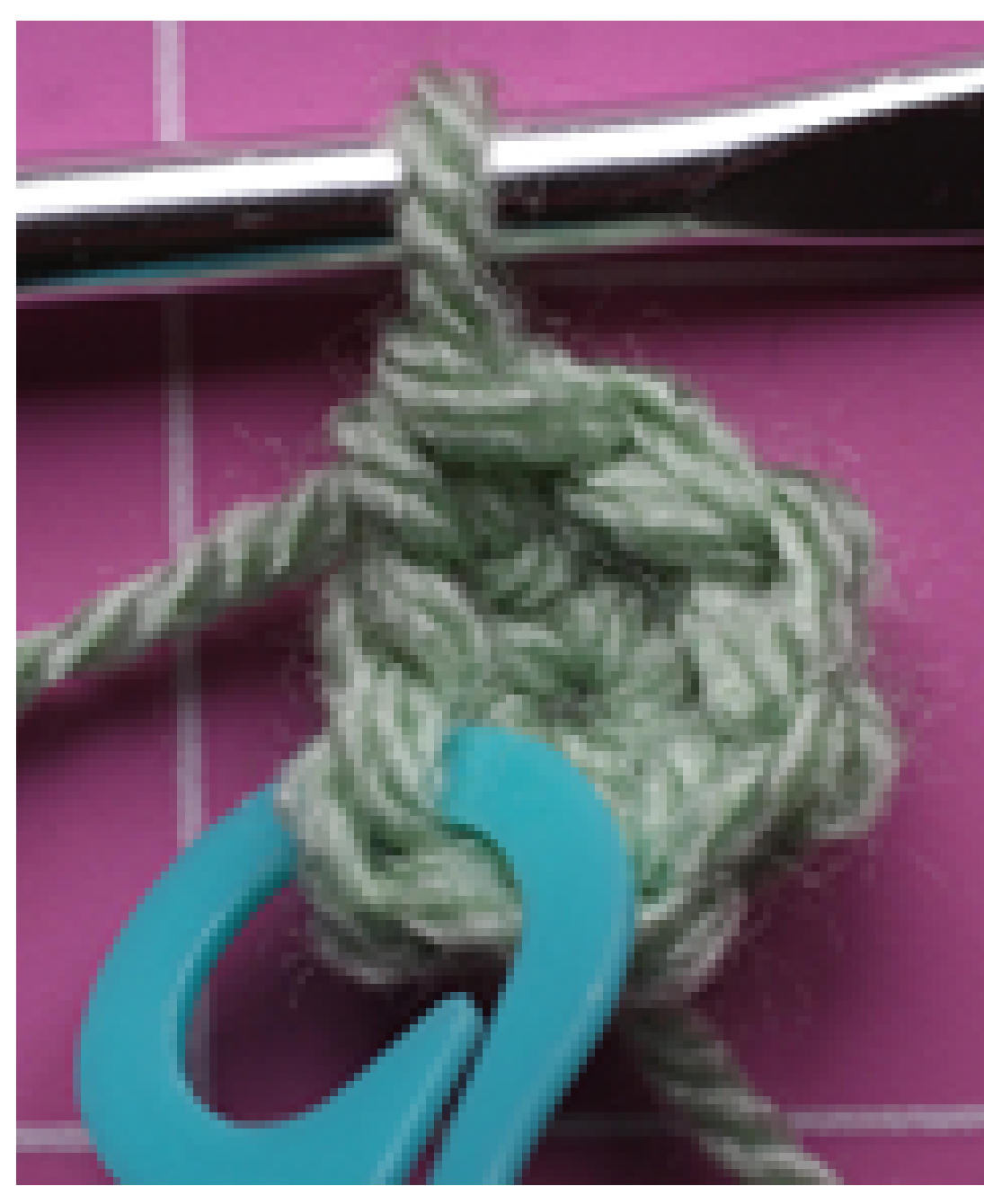
To Start.

Make a magic circle (also known as an adjustable ring).



Round 1.

Make 6 double crochet (dc) around the circle and pull tight to close. You should now have 6 stitches (6sts)



Round 2.

1 dc into each st of round 1. The stitch marker shows where I started the round.

Round 3. dc into the next st then dc twice into the following st. Repeat this twice more. (9sts).

Round 4. 1dc into each st (9sts)

Round 5. (1 dc into next 2 sts, 2 dc in next st) x 3 (12sts)

Round 6. 1dc into each st (12sts)

Round 7. (1dc into next 3 sts, 2dc in next st) x 3 (15sts)

Round 8. 1dc into each st. (15sts)

Round 9. (1dc into next 4 sts, 2dc in next st) x 3 (18sts)

Round 10. 1dc into each st (18 sts)

Continue increasing every other round by 3 sts until tree is the desired height.

Fasten off & weave in yarn ends.
