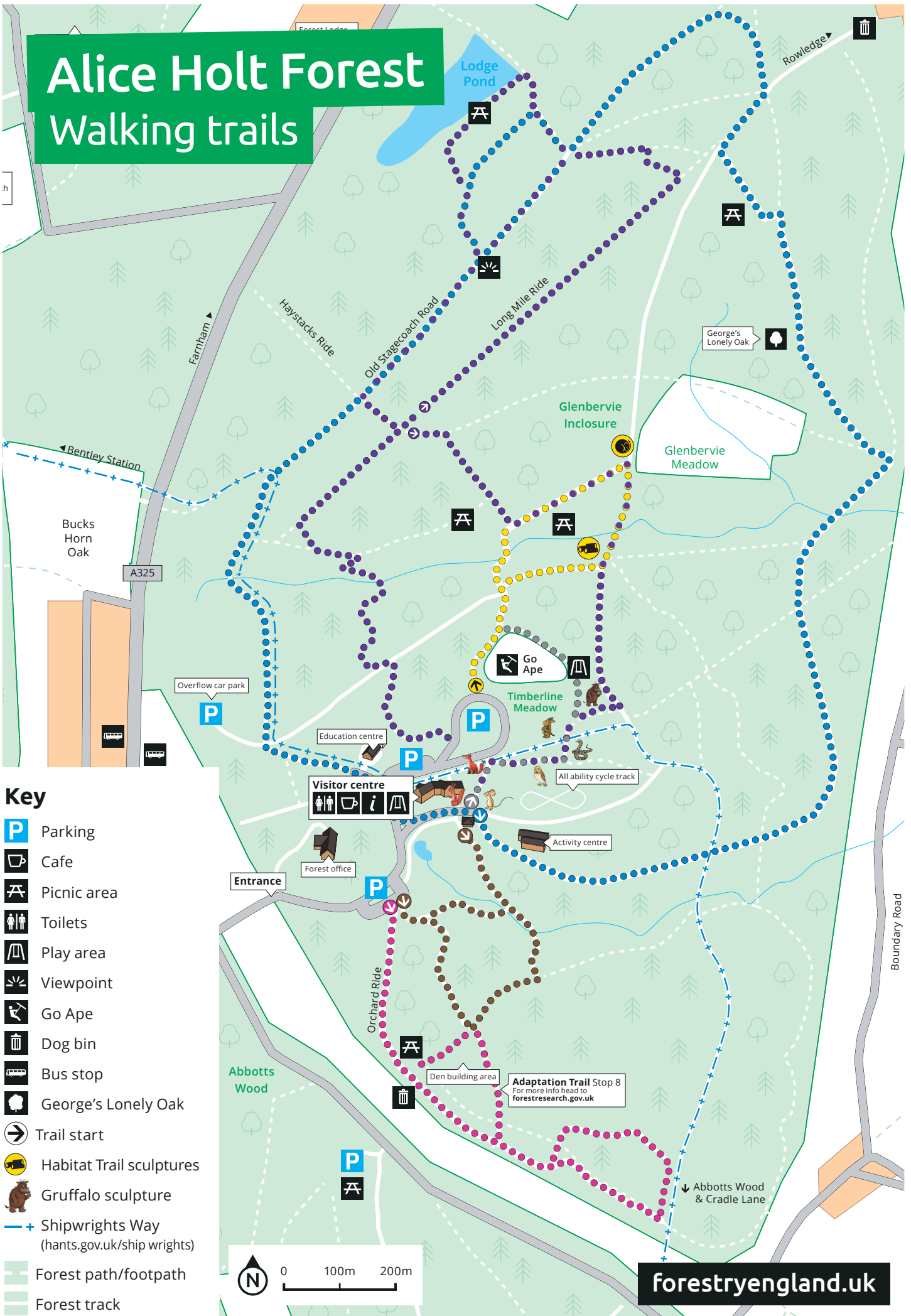
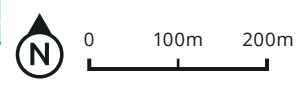

Walking trails at Alice Holt Forest

Whether you're looking for play and adventure or a bit of peace and quiet to observe wildlife, we've got a trail for you.

Trail information

- Timberline Trail** ●●●
0.5 km (0.3 miles)
A family walk with play structures leading to the Habitat Trail.
- Willows Green Trail** ●●●
1 km (0.6 miles)
An attractive trail with one steep section and an optional shorter route.
- Lodge Pond Trail** ●●●
4 km (2.5 miles)
A more 'off-road' trail to Lodge Pond, muddy in places but very beautiful.
- Habitat Trail** ●●●
1 km (0.6 miles)
A family walk with giant play sculptures.
- Easy Access Trail** ●●●
2 km (1.5 miles)
Suitable for wheelchair and pushchair users, this trail takes you through a variety of woodland and has an optional shortcut.
- Family Cycle Trail** ●●●
5 km (3 miles)
A relatively easy ride around the forest with some steep hills.
