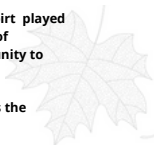
The project has an environmental focus, and explores the critical connection between humans and trees...



What the artists have been up to...

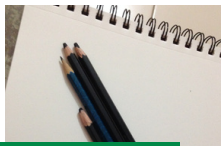
During the workshops, the artists were encouraged to really connect with the trees around them, whether they were at Westonbirt, or in their own local area.
