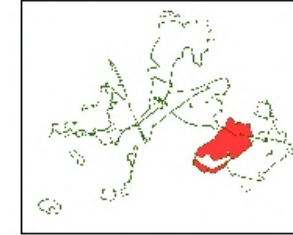


The shape and timing of clearfell patterns that cross the mountain bike trails have been designed to reduce the change to large sections of the trails at any one period and will in time create a more diverse environment for the cyclists.

The proposed clearfell programme will kept under review and will be reactive to changes, the timings of which may be adjusted due to changes in tree health.

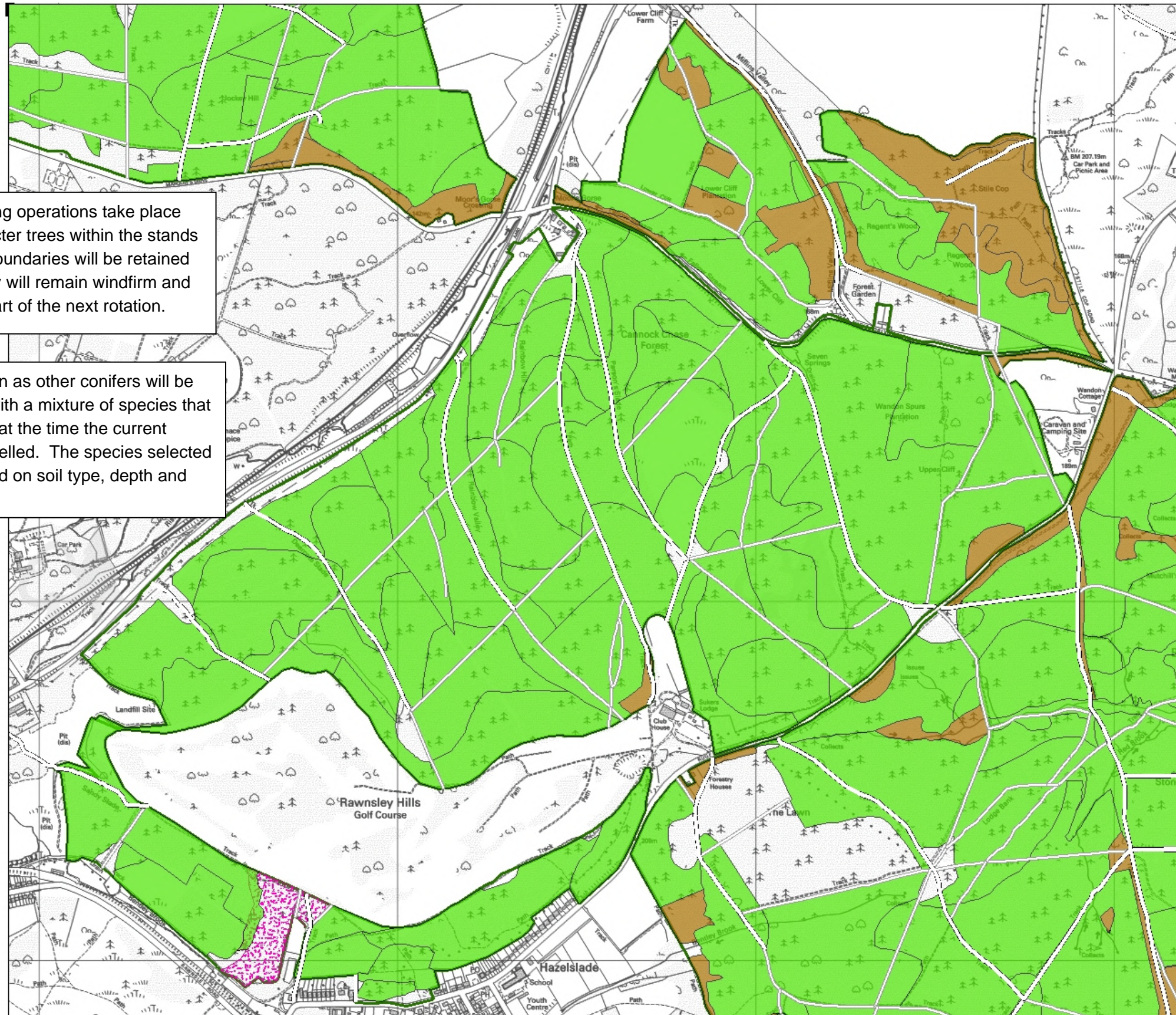

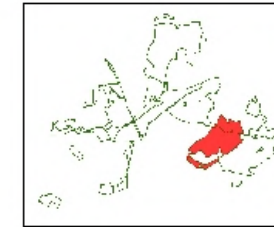
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When felling operations take place any character trees within the stands or along boundaries will be retained where they will remain windfirm and become part of the next rotation.

Areas shown as other conifers will be restocked with a mixture of species that are chosen at the time the current stands are felled. The species selected will be based on soil type, depth and hydrology.
