



Walking trails at

Fineshade Wood

Venture deep into the woodland. With an easy access trail and two longer trails to choose from, there is something for everyone.

Trail information

The Smelters Walk •••

3km (2 miles)

A route suitable for wheelchairs and pushchairs, on level or gently sloping surfaced paths. It passes through areas where iron was once smelted. To find your way around the trail, follow the yellow waymarkers.

The Dales Wood Walk •••

5km (3 miles)

Gently hilly in places, this trail winds through a variety of habitats, with a different view around almost every corner! Early on, you can take a short detour to visit the wildlife hide should you wish to do so. Some sections are shared with cyclists and horse riders. Follow the purple waymarkers.

The Mill Wood Trail • • • 8.5km (5.5 miles)

This trail takes you to the furthest reaches of the wood through a variety of landscapes. It has a range of gradients and surfaces, and some parts may be muddy during wet periods. You may meet cyclists and horse riders as you walk round. Follow the pink waymarkers.
