

Discovery Trail ●●● 2.5km (1.5 miles)

A fully surfaced gentle trail, suitable for wheelchairs and pushchairs, with regular resting points. Stunning views and children's play features make this enjoyable for everyone. This is a multi-use trail, please be aware of cyclists and other users.

Raptor Trail ••• 4.5km (3 miles)

Explore the wide variety of forest environments and experience some of the wildlife living here on this fully surfaced track. Take the small detour to visit the bird of prey viewpoint. Suitable for energetic families, be prepared for a few steep ascents and descents.

Butterfly Trail OOO 6km (4 miles)

Discover rare butterflies in the peaceful depths of the forest. This trail has varied surfaces and is steep in places. It shares its start with the Discovery Trail, until the waymarked turn. Please be aware of cyclists and other users along this section.
