In the 1930s, unemployed men had to work in the forest for six months and lived in a camp of huts here at High Lodge.

This is the very shallow depression to the right of the viewing platform

The low bank



This marked the edge of a plantation in the nineteenth century (at least 100 years before Thetford Forest was planted)

These mark a bank which must be protected from forest machinery

## The ridge and furrow



Made by a small plough- not for growing crops but for planting the young trees
