






Walking trails at

Jeskyns Community Woodlands

There are miles of tracks to discover here at Jeskyns, explore the woodland along one of these four routes.



Trail information

Court Wood Trail

0.8km (0.5 miles) Easy

A short surfaced loop which passes by our Sand Pit Play Area and Fairy Village. Dogs must be kept on a lead in some parts. Surfaced with gradients less than 1:20 and plenty of resting points.

Henhurst Lake Walk 000

2.5km (1.5 miles) Easy

On this surfaced trail you will pass by young woodlands, a Treehouse Play Area and Henhurst Lake. Dogs must be kept on a lead in some parts. Surfaced with gradients less than 1:20 and plenty of resting points.

Broomfield Loop

2.8km (1.75 miles) Moderate

A surfaced loop which also takes in our grazing meadows and leads up to view point with two towering sculptures. Mainly off lead for dogs with one small area on lead back up to the café. Surfaced with gradients less than 1:20 and plenty of resting points.

Orchard Walk

3km (2 miles) Easy

Add this loop to either the Henhurst Lake Walk or Broomfield Loop to see our orchards of plums, apples and cobnuts. All off lead. Surfaced with gradients less than 1:20 and plenty of resting points.
