# Walking trails at Mallards Pike

There are miles of tracks to discover here at Mallards Pike, or you can explore the woodland along one of these routes.

## Trail information

### The Soudley Circles Walks ●●●

5km (3 miles) **2 hours**

The Forest of Dean Ramblers have three circular walks between Mallards Pike and Soudley Ponds, each three miles in length, with climbs and a variety of views. The walks can be combined into a pleasant ten mile hike.

Ramblers routes leaflets and maps are required.

### Mallards Pike path (not waymarked)

0.8km (½ mile) **30 mins**

This lakeside path is surfaced for wheelchairs and pushchairs. There are several benches along the way to stop and enjoy the scenery.

### Wenchford Link Trail ○○○

3km (1.8 miles) **1 hour**

This path links Mallards Pike to the popular summer picnic site of Wenchford. Following a stoned forest road for most of its length, the path runs through woodland rich in relics of its industrial past.

### Blackpool Brook Trail ●●●

1km (0.6 miles) **30 mins**

Wenchford is a great spot for a relaxing picnic or BBQ. There is a short surfaced trail around the site.
