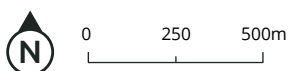
## Walking trails

# Walking trails at Mallards Pike

There are miles of tracks to discover here at Mallards Pike, or you can explore the woodland along one of these routes.

## Mallards Pike path

**Not waymarked**

**0.8 km** (½ mile)

This lakeside path is surfaced for wheelchairs and pushchairs. There are several benches along the way to stop and enjoy the scenery.

## The Soudley Circles Walks ●●●

**5 km** (3 miles)

The Forest of Dean Ramblers have three circular walks between Mallards Pike and Soudley Ponds, each three miles long, with climbs and a variety of views. Can be combined into a pleasant ten mile hike. Ramblers routes leaflets and maps are required. Available from fodramblers.org.uk. These trails are not fully waymarked and so an OS Explorer Map OL14 is advised.

## Blackpool Brook Trail ●●●

**1 km** (0.6 miles)

Wenchford is a great picnic spot. There is a short, surfaced trail around the picnic area, or take the slightly longer trail which can be muddy at times.

## 2 km Running Trail ●●●

(1.2 miles)

A level and surfaced route into the forest, returning on the Mallards Colliers Trail link path. A great beginners route to step up from the Lakeside path.

## 3 km Running Trail ●●●

(1.8 miles)

The trail follows the majority of the 5km route but has a short hill climb in the northern section.
