2.4km (1.5 miles)

Short loop: 1.6km (1 miles)

Choose the 1 mile or 1.5 mile loop, both waymarked so you can relax and enjoy the scenery. The trail is wide and level, with rest points along the way. Explore beautiful forest and take in one of the best panoramic views of Devon.

The forest code

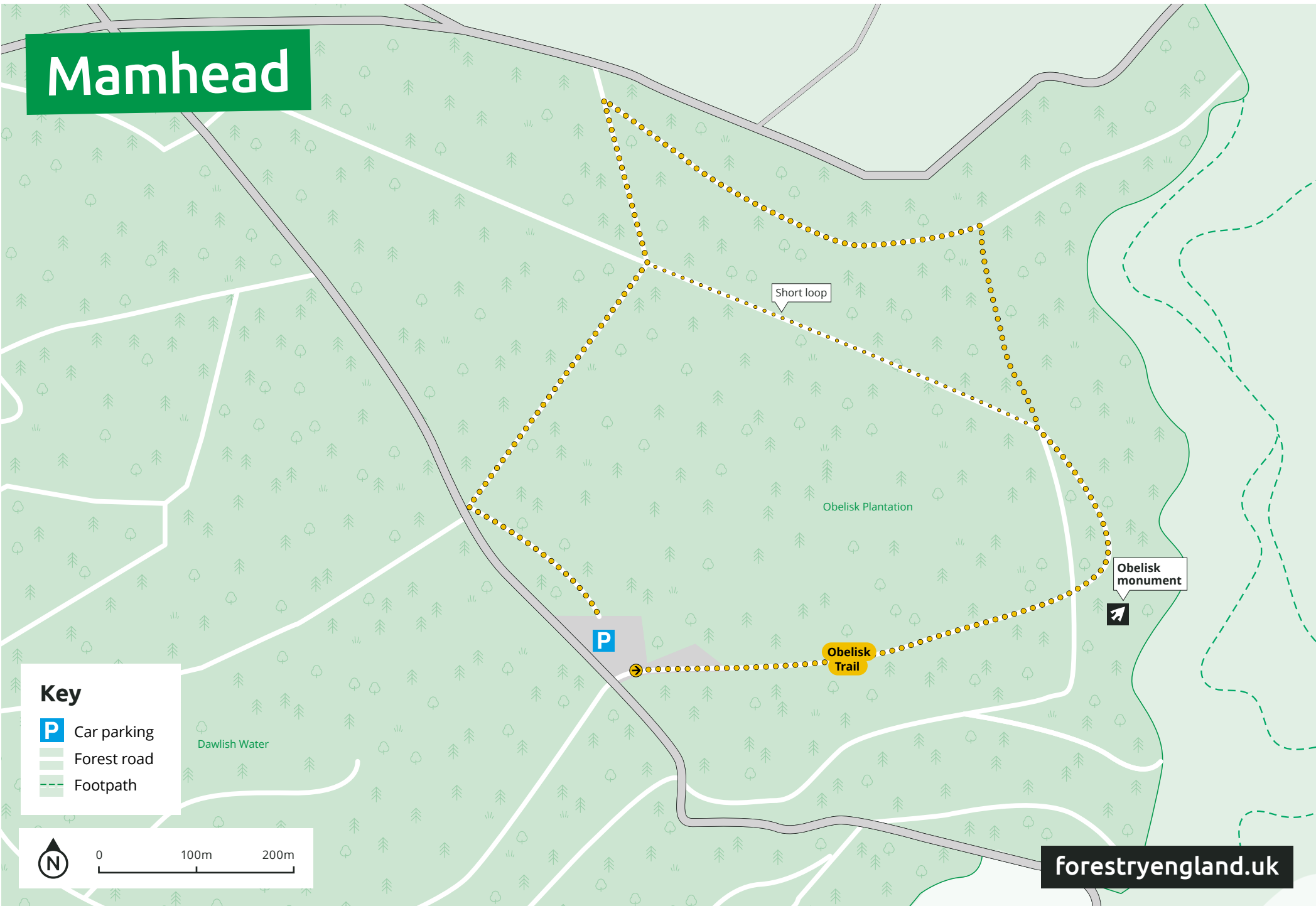
- Protect and respect wildlife, plants and trees.
