

The presence of the National Park, SAC, SSSI and registered park and Garden will be taken into account when operations are planned.

There are a number of wetland habitats and water features. Most notable of which is the wet woodland habitat in the southern half of Sticks Wood.

The presence of DNB is having a major impact on the heath of the Lodgepole pine and the yield from the Corsican pine stands.

The presence of *Phytophthora ramorum* in the local area makes the larch stands very susceptible to infection.

The neighbouring woodland has a strong presence in the local landscape and combined with the FP woodlands creates an integral mix of conifer and broadleaf woodlands.

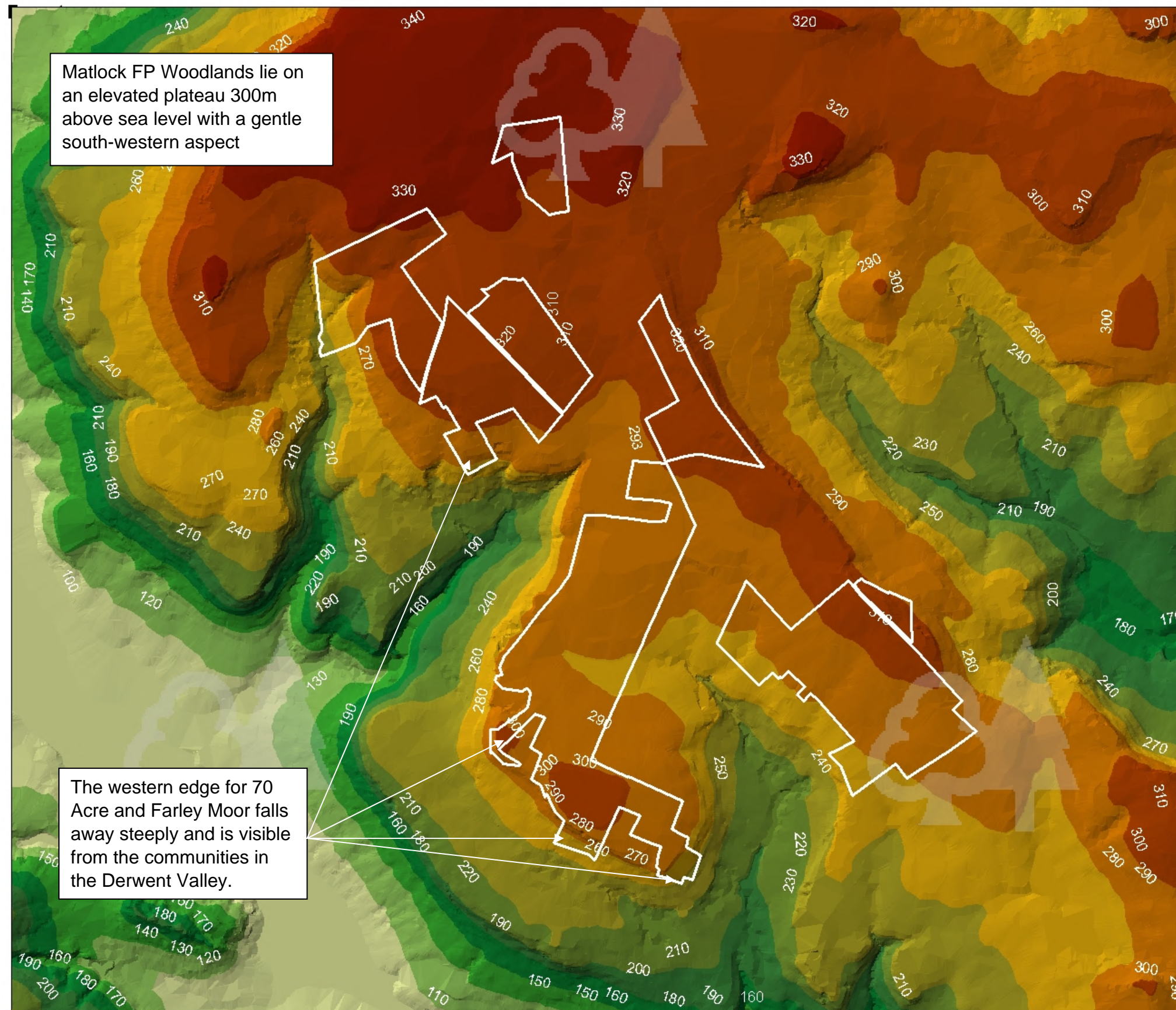
