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The gentle sloping elevations of Russells give way to a much steeper more diverse landform on the eastern side of Nagshead; created by the steep sided valleys that run from the Cannop Valley up onto the plateau of Nagshead in the west.



Lower elevations run north from Parkend up the Cannop Valley to Mireystock crossroads and beyond, with the County road cutting along the valley bottom.

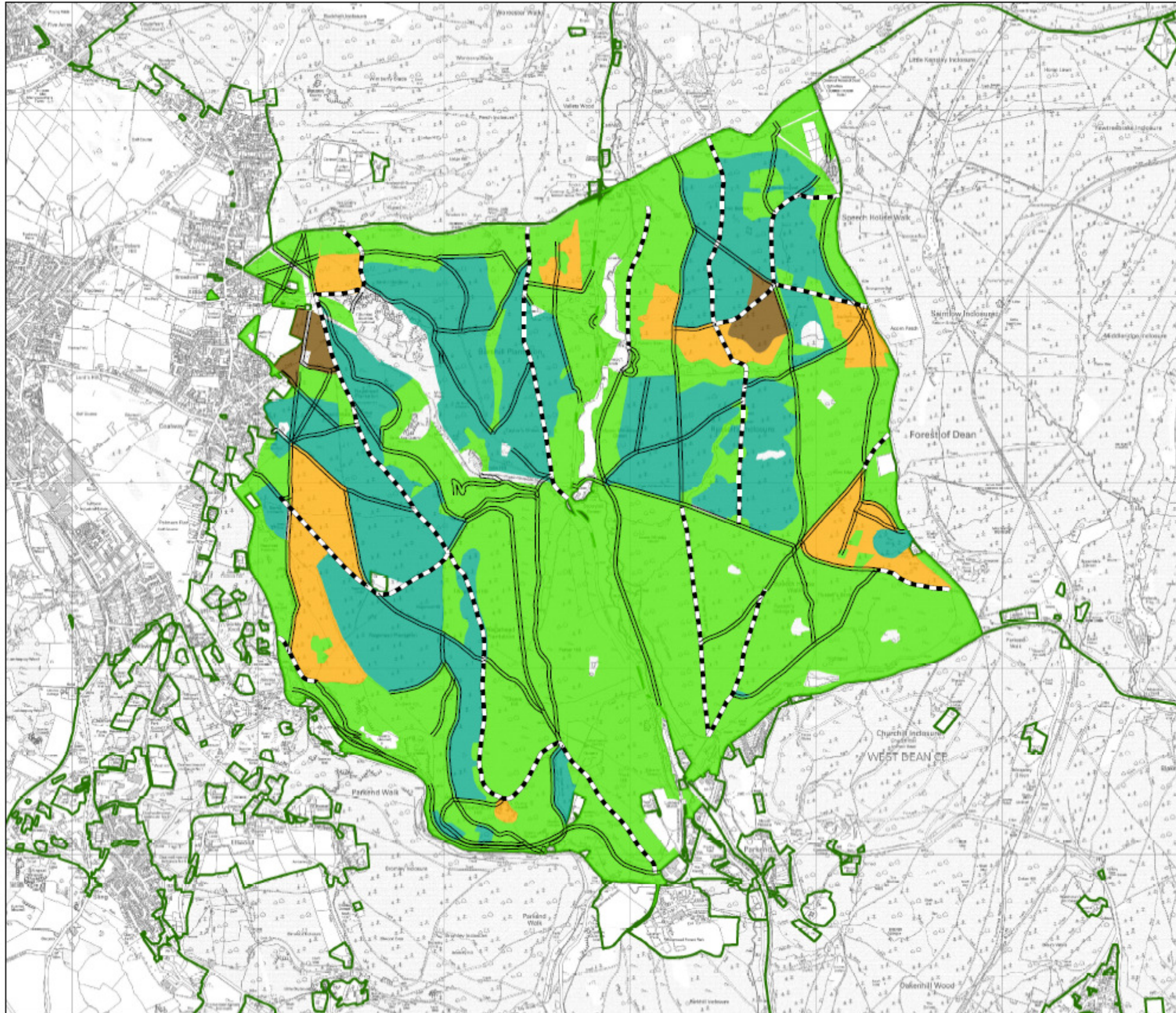

(principal component)**

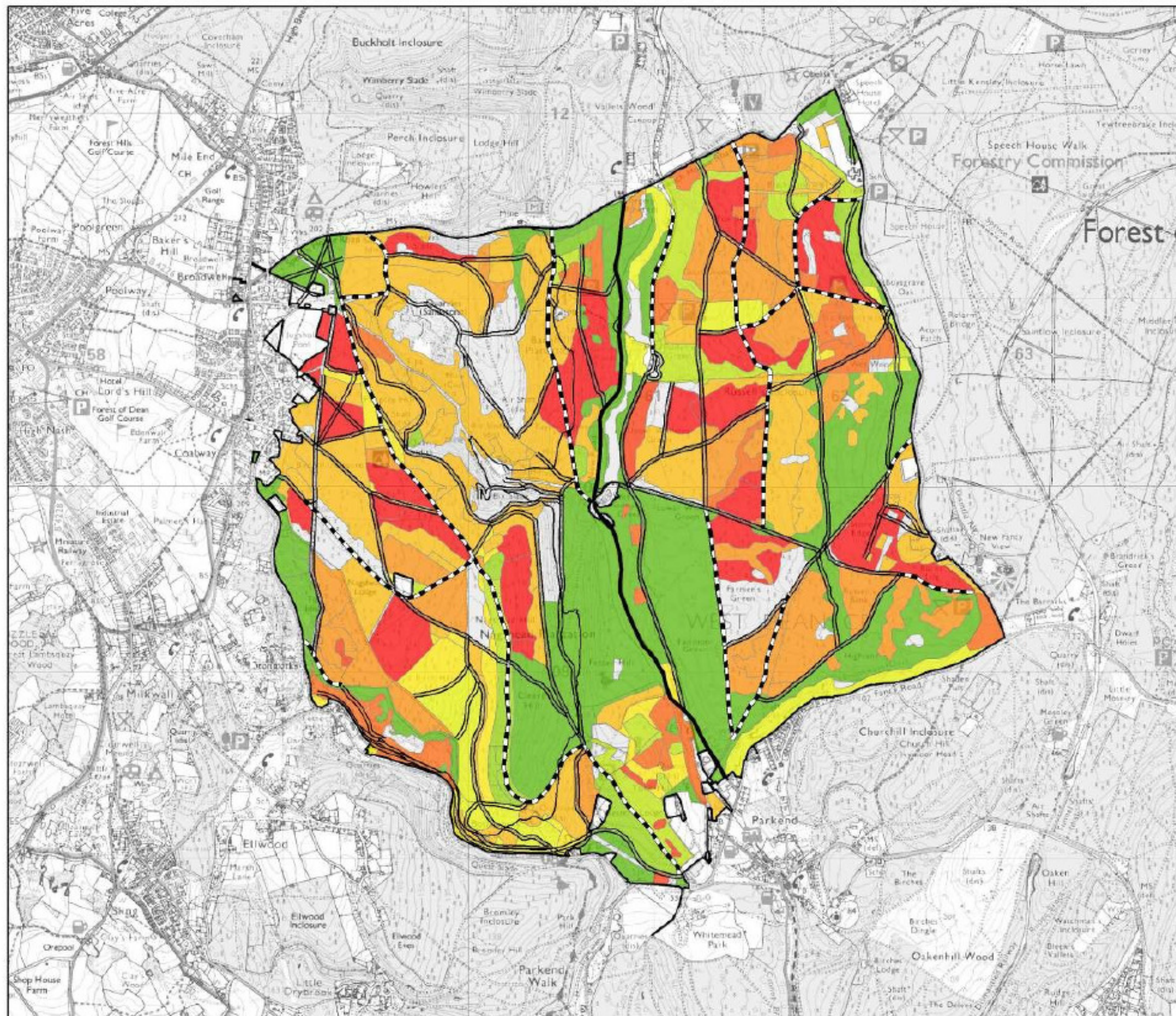

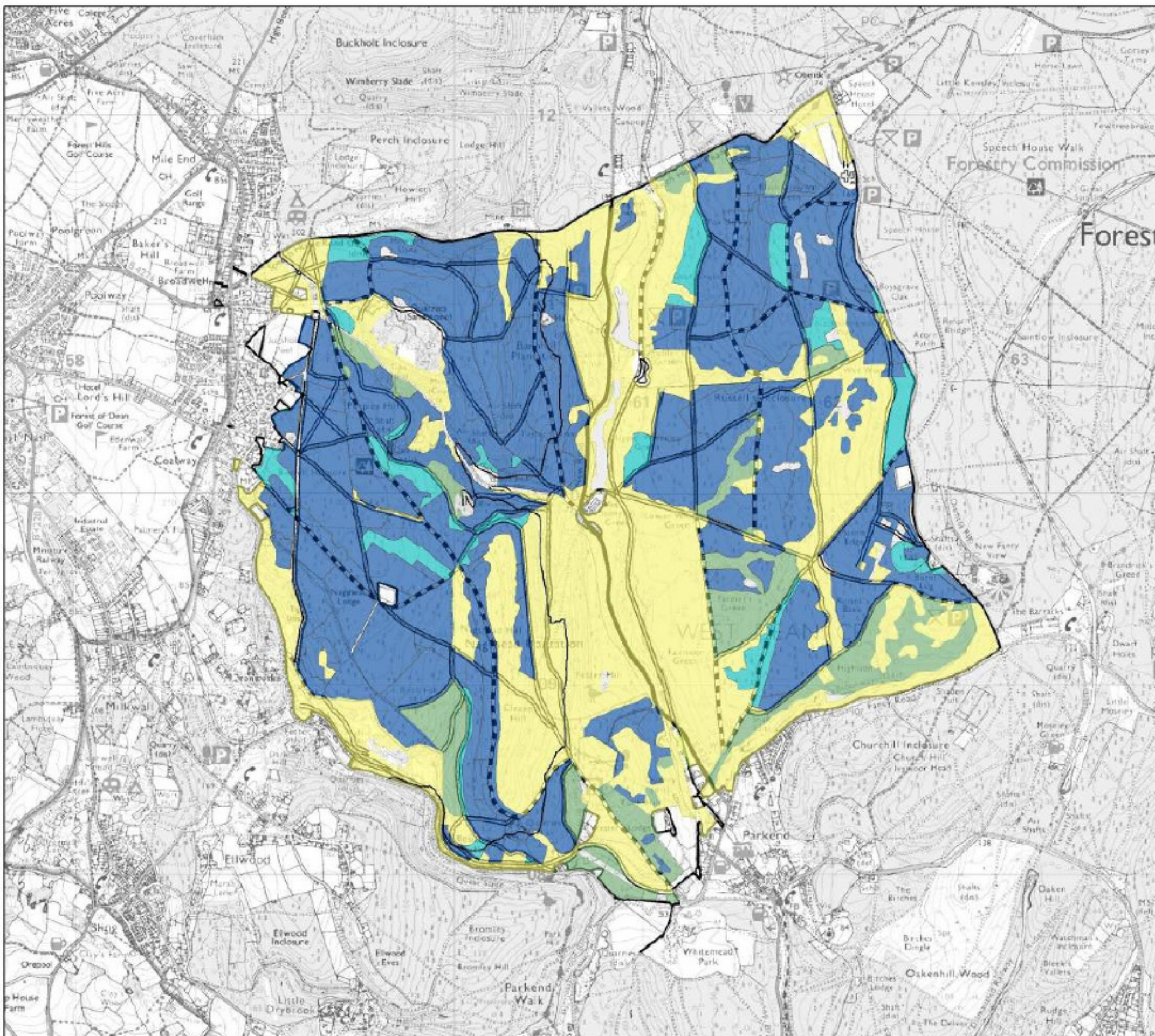
