



# Plant hunter orienteering course

## Brief description

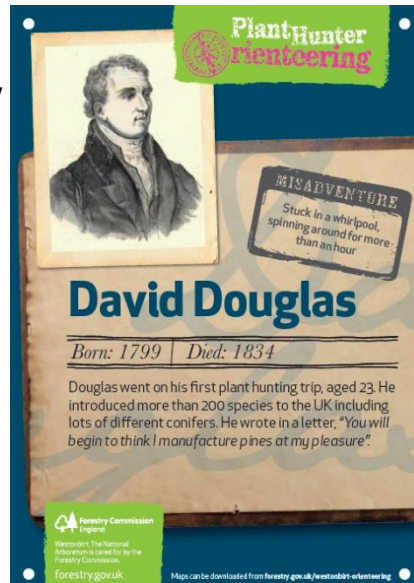
Look out for the A5 panels attached to posts as you follow the map.

The Plant Hunter Orienteering logos on the panels are colour coded either green, pink, blue or orange.

For the short course you are looking for stops 1-8, colour coded pink and green. There will be four to find of each colour and each set will give you

- The name of a plant hunter
- A country they visited
- Two trees they introduced into Britain - you'll the species of tree at these stops.

The long course involves all 16 stops, four of each colour.
