# Walking trails at Sherwood Pines

Enjoy one of our walking trails, which guide you through a variety of habitats and play areas nestled among the trees.

## Archer's Stroll ○○○

1.6km (1 mile)

**Shortcut:** 1km (2/3 mile)

A gentle, all-weather, surfaced trail perfect for families, combining nature, mindful moments, history and family fun. Follow the white waymarkers.

 Suitable for pushchairs, wheelchairs and mobility aids.

## Castle Walk ●●○

4.8km (3 miles)

A mid-length, low-intensity unsurfaced route, perfect if you'd like to explore more of the forest and spend a little longer among the trees. This trail guides you through a rich mix of forest habitats, from mature pine woodland to open lowland heathland. Follow the pink waymarkers.

## Ranger's Path ●●●

8km (5 miles)

The Ranger's Path is our longest trail stretching through different types of woodland. The walk will see you immersed in the peace and quiet of the forest, and allows you to appreciate the rich history and nature of the area. The trail is not very smooth in some parts so may not be suitable for all pushchairs or wheelchairs. Follow the brown waymarkers.
