



Gaps illustrate open space, areas covered by recent natural regeneration, non woodland areas or missing data.













Queen Elizabeth Country Park & West Harting Down Indicative Species Diversity





Managed Native Woodland

Predominantly (>80%) conifer woodland



Mixed Woodland Management

Woodland consisting of a mixture of native and non-native tree species, neither of which dominates more than 80% of the canopy.

Mature Yew woodland combined with a mosiac of open space and scrub habitat.



Recreation Area

Area managed primarily for formal and informal recreation.




