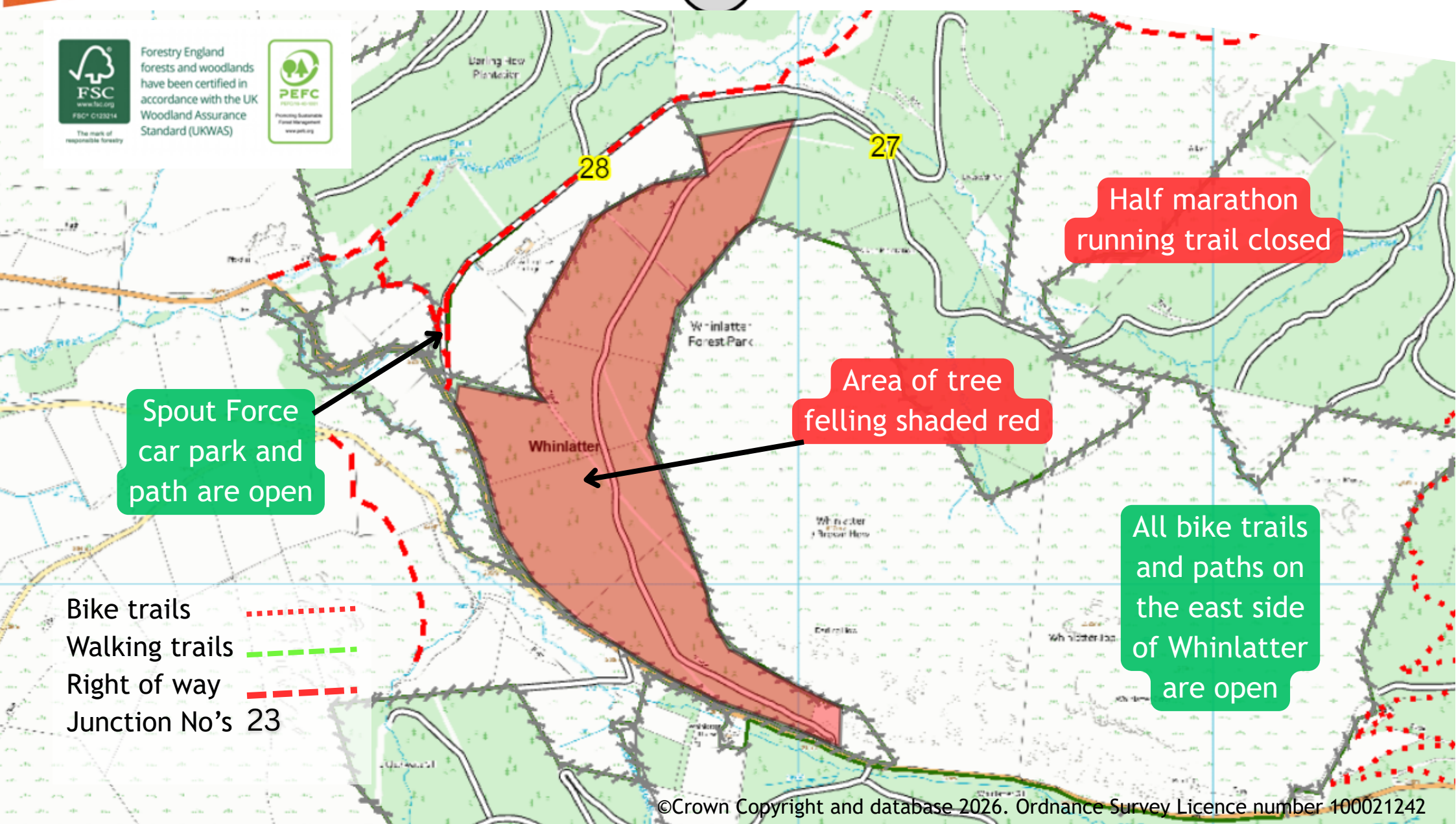

Whinlatter Tree Felling and Extraction

Tree felling has moved to the less busy north west quarter of Whinlatter for the summer holidays. The half marathon running route is closed. All the bike trails, walking and running routes on the east side of Whinlatter are open. Harvesting will move back to the east side of Whinlatter in September 2026. We are sorry for any inconvenience.

We are thinning the forest by removing up to 20% of the trees to create more space for nature, improve tree stability and produce timber.

Falling trees and forestry machines are extremely dangerous. Harvesting machines operate early mornings, late nights and weekends. Please follow all safety signs, avoid the area, and watch out for timber lorries on forest roads between the site and the B5292.
