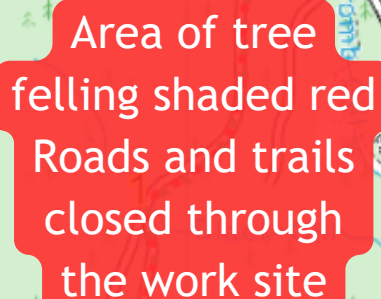

Whinlatter Tree Felling and Extraction

Tree felling is continuing in Whinlatter. We are thinning the forest by removing up to 20% of the trees to create more space for nature, improve tree stability and produce timber.

The red shaded area including the forest road is closed to public access, the Thornthwaite bridleway and Offroad C2C are diverted. The North Red and South Red bike trails are open. The Quercus bike trail is diverted along the public road. Some other running and walking trails are also affected. This area of the forest will reopen towards the end of September when work will move to Tarbarrel Moss, north of the Visitor Centre.

Falling trees and forestry machines are extremely dangerous. Harvesting machines operate early mornings, late nights and weekends. Please follow all safety signs, avoid the area, and watch out for timber lorries on forest roads between the site and the B5292.
