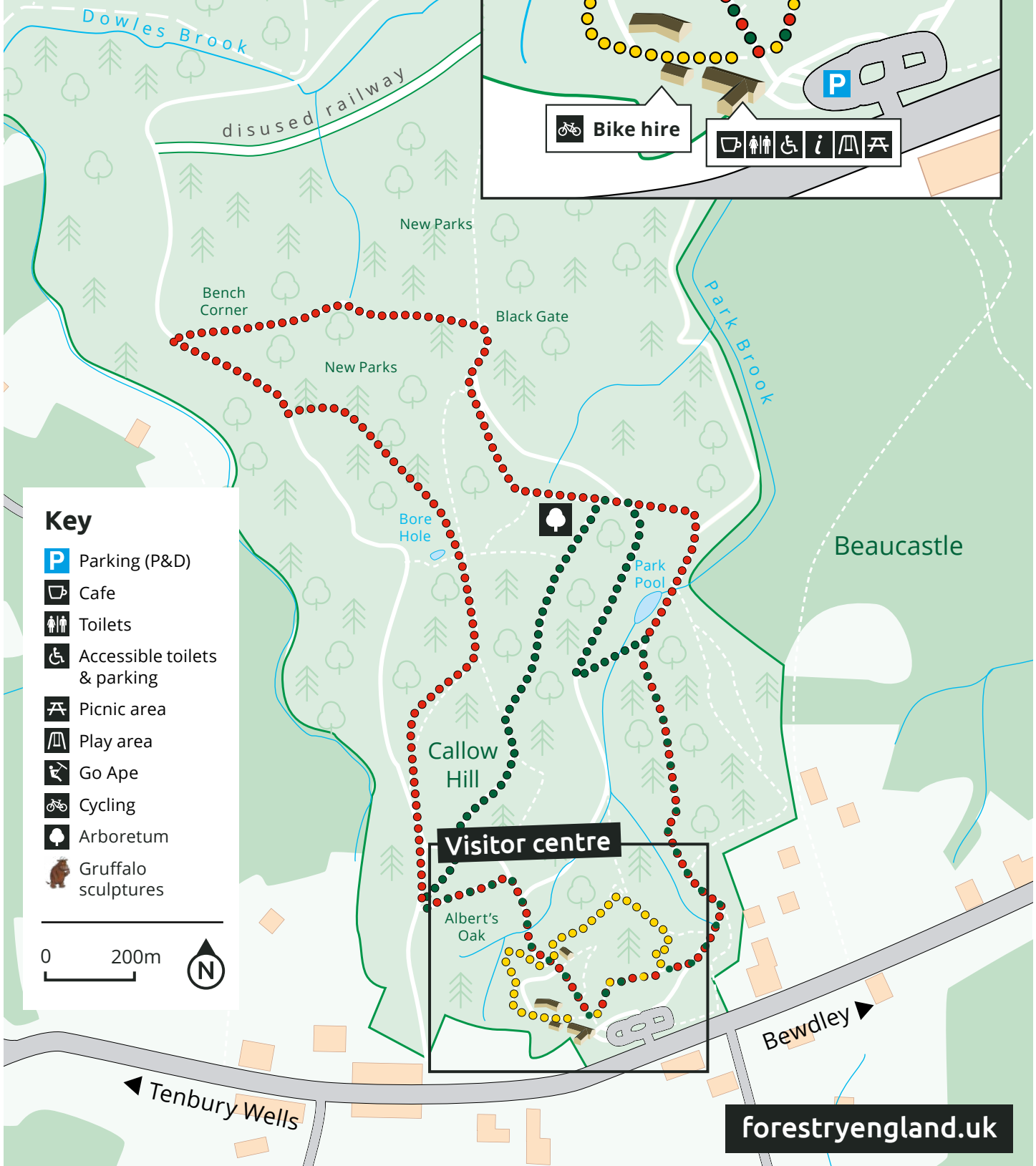


# Wyre Forest

### Visitor centre

# Wyre Forest

Wyre Forest encompasses a vast area of natural beauty. Enjoy our waymarked walking trails throughout the seasons, with no two visits being the same.

## Trail information

All of our walking trails start from our Callow Hill Visitor Centre.

### Wren Trail ●●●

1.2km (0.8 miles)

A great all-ability trail with plenty of benches to stop and relax along the way. Keep your eyes peeled for the Go Ape cabin, the sleeping Gruffalo and the Gruffalo's Child.

### Woodpecker Trail ●●●

3.5 km (2.2 miles)

Enter the 'Valley of the Giants' and pass the Whittyppear. Learn about life in the forest on our seasonal learning panels. Whilst you can push a buggy around the trail, please note that there are some sections which are steep, have exposed roots or can get muddy after wet weather.

### Buzzard Trail ●●●

5 km (3 miles)

This is our longest walking trail and takes you through mixed woodland and forest pools. Discover the variety of trees in our arboretum. Sections of the trail have exposed roots and rocks, and some parts will be muddy especially after wet weather.
