Tree felling and extraction in Ennerdale

Tree felling and extraction work is continuing in Latterbarrow, north of Ennerdale YHA. All the larch trees within the red and orange shaded areas will be felled as they are infected with *Phytophthora* larch disease. Non larch species will also be felled for access and where they are not windfirm enough to be left standing on their own. Harvesting work has completed in Silvercove, the area is open to public access. Please look out for harvesting debris and areas of mud. We will reinstate the surface of the right of way through the site. Sorry if this causes you an inconvenience. For more information visit wildennerdale.co.uk/forest.

Falling trees are very dangerous and so are the felling and extraction machines. If a machine's saw chain breaks, metal can shoot through the forest like a bullet. **Harvesting machines operate long hours including late night, early mornings and at weekends.** Please, look out for timber lorries, observe all safety signs and stay clear of this area. Thank you.
